


A temporary ban on the online version of Tuoi Tre was announced by the Ministry of Information on 16 July. The reason given was the publication of "untrue" information about the president, Tran Dai Quang.

Along with a fine of 220 million dong (9,500 dollars), Tuoi Tre Online was required to make an official apology and correct the "false" information. Since 17 October 2018, it has been allowed to go online again.
