Queering is a bold display font inspired by protest posters and queer publications updated for the modern age. The name Queering comes from the activity of 'Queering a Space' — transgressing what are seen as fixed categories — such as gender and sexuality.

Version 2.0 of Queering is fully reimagined, with three new weights, Latin Extended and Cyrillic¹ support, as well as a vast library of glyphs that scale with each weight for maximum impact.

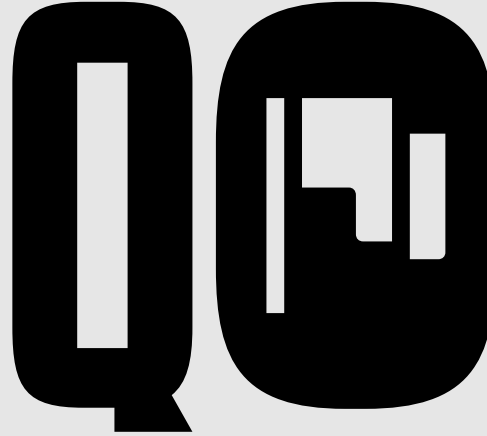


Scale

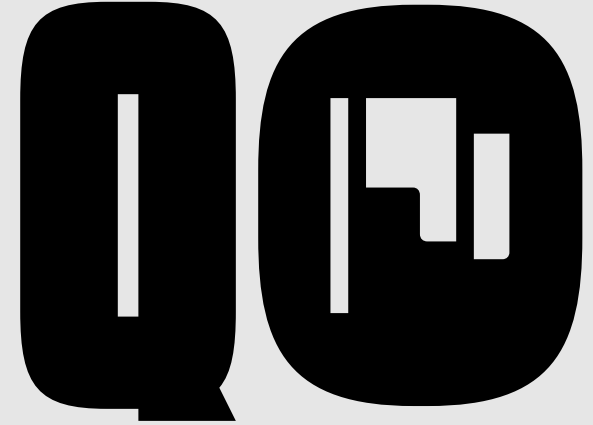
Queering's glyphs scale in diameter based on the weight chosen. This extends the scale for maximum impact with each weight.



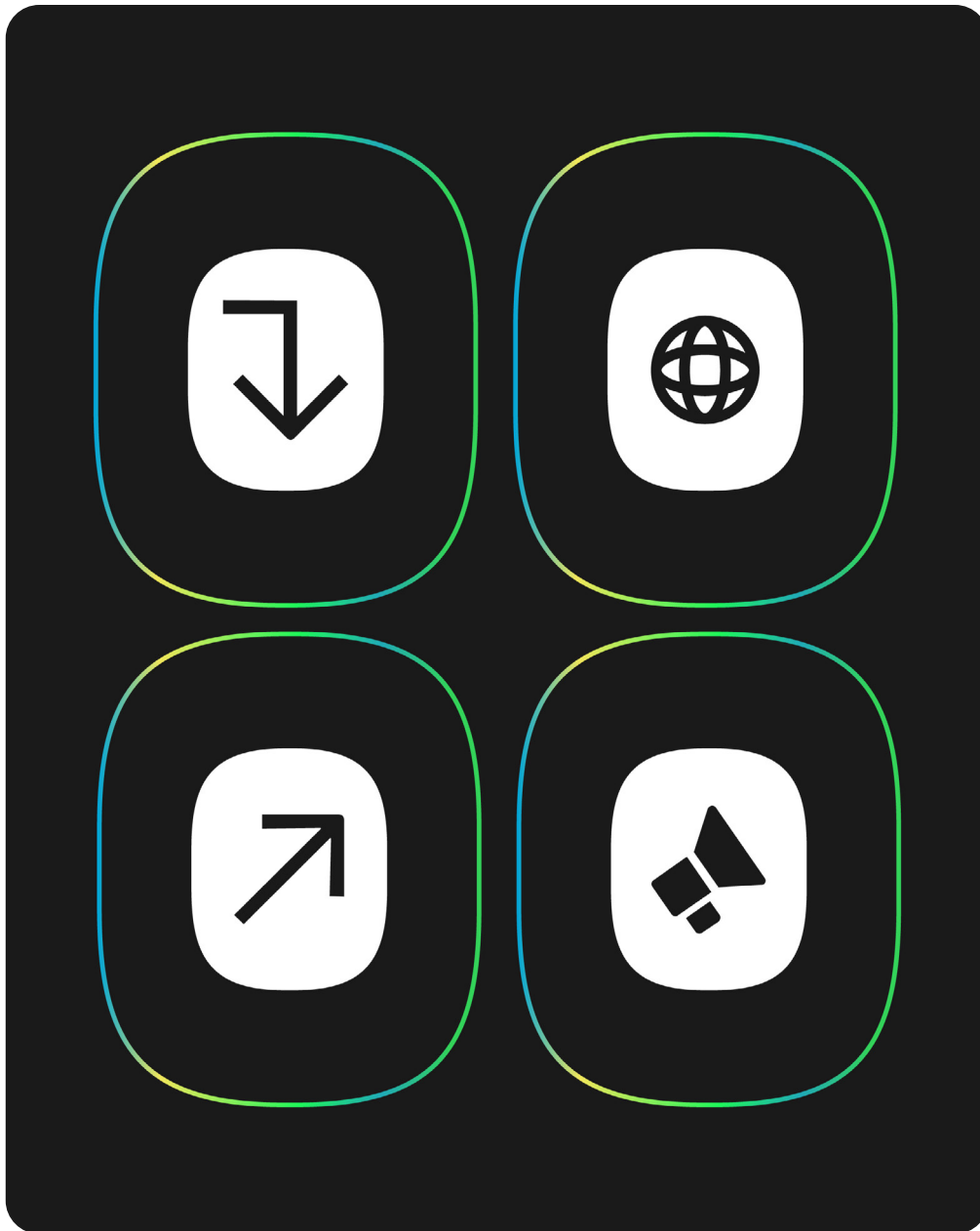
